- **Middle East (Israel, Egypt, Lebanon, Iraq twice).**
- **Caucasus region (former USSR): Chechnya, Abkhazia, S. Ossetia, N. Ossetia, Kabardino-Balkharia).**
- **South and Central America (where to start: Paraguay, Argentina, Brazil, Chile, etc).**
- **Eastern Europe (East Germany, Poland, Hungary, Czechoslovakia, Poland again, Bosnia).**
- **Africa (Kenya, South Africa, Rwanda, Sudan, etc etc etc).**
